A Year in Review

As a new year begins, we here at Chicago House always take a moment to look at what we have accomplished in the last year with the support of our friends and supporters.

In 2011 Chicago House:



* Provided stable homes for over 190 individuals in 4 residential programs.

*Community Case Managers met with over 100 community-based clients, linking them with services to maximize the length of time they can live fully and comfortably in their own homes.

*Offered over 1,000 individuals HIV prevention education and risk reduction counseling for people living with HIV, as well as HIV testing.

*Served more than 250 HIV-positive and at-risk adults in our iFour Employment Program, providing them with skills, training, and individualized support to help secure and retain employment. We also graduated our 118th client in our workshop for the Sweet Miss Giving's Transitional Jobs program!

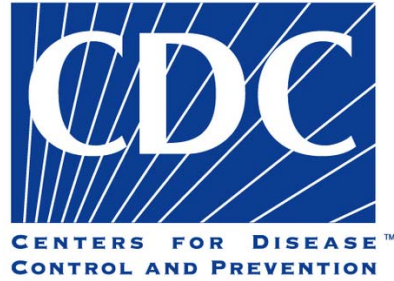
*Helped more than 100 low-income adults - who were previously homeless or at risk for homelessness - gain stable employment with average wage more than 20% above minimum wage.

Chicago House is excited to announce a new partnership with Center on Halsted! Thanks to a grant from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Center on Halsted, along with Chicago House and other community agencies, has launched the YMSM Project, which provides HIV testing, counseling, and structured interventions to prevent HIV among young men of color, one of Chicago's most at-risk populations. This collaboration enables us to combine expertise, resources, and services to make an important impact on the spread of HIV/AIDS with vulnerable youth.
