About Madeleine Albright: Albright was the 64th Secretary of State of the United States. In 1997, she was named the first female Secretary of State and became, at that time, the highest ranking woman in the history of the U.S. government. As Secretary of State, Albright reinforced America's alliances, advocated democracy and human rights and promoted American trade and business, labor and environmental standards abroad.

If you have recently moved, chances are you will need to re-register to vote. If you aren't sure as to whether or not you are registered to vote, you can find out by visiting www.elections.il.gov.



Registering to vote is easy! You can download the registration form [here](#), and then mail it in - but be sure it is postmarked by October 5th! If you miss the 10/5 deadline, you can still register to vote by going in-person 10/6-10/26 at various locations, including your local library and DMV.
