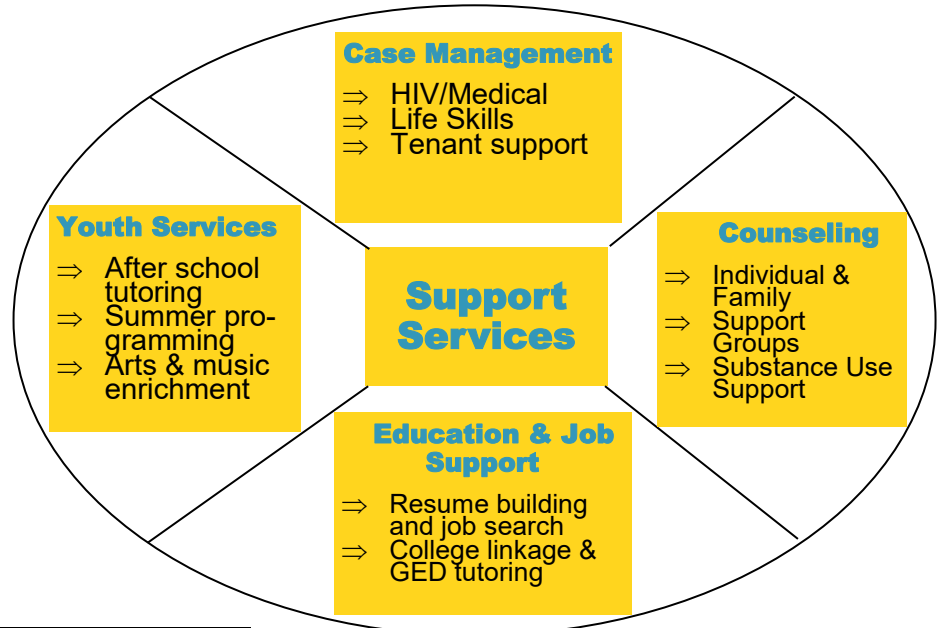

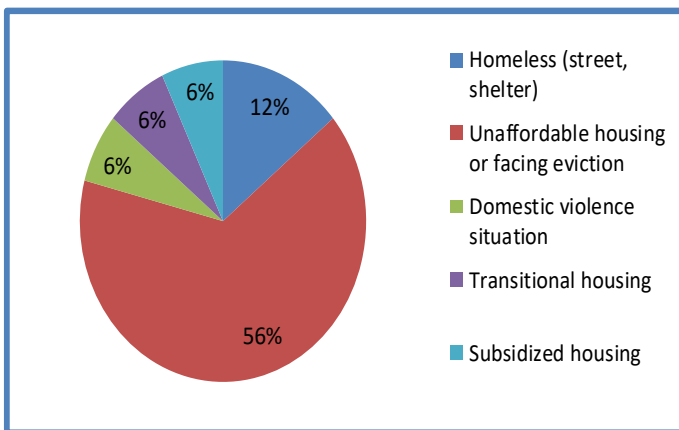

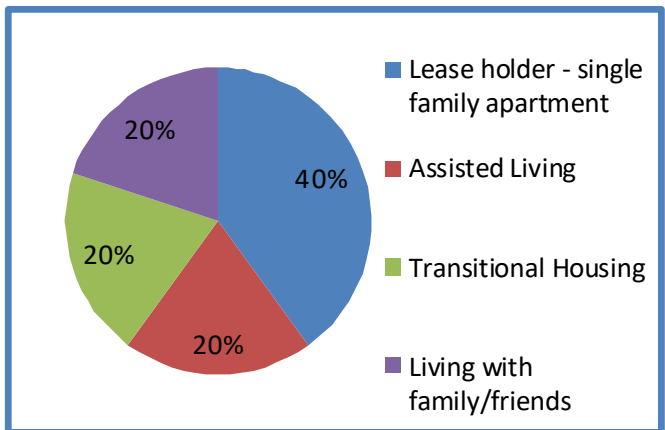

Housing Status at Intake

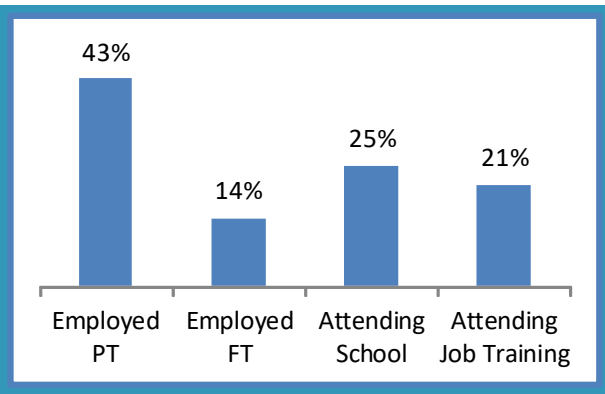


Housing Status at Discharge

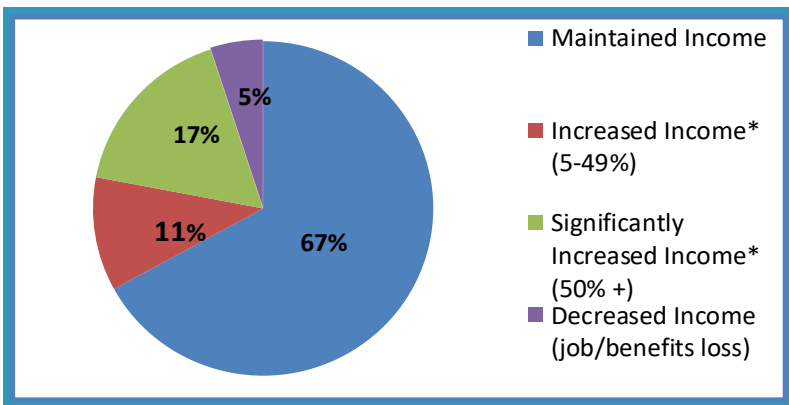




Adult Employment & Education



Household Income



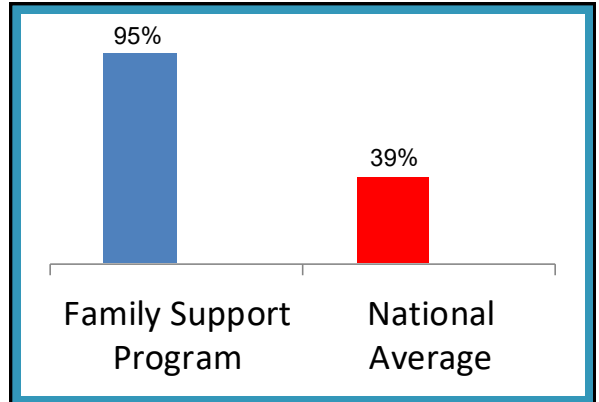
