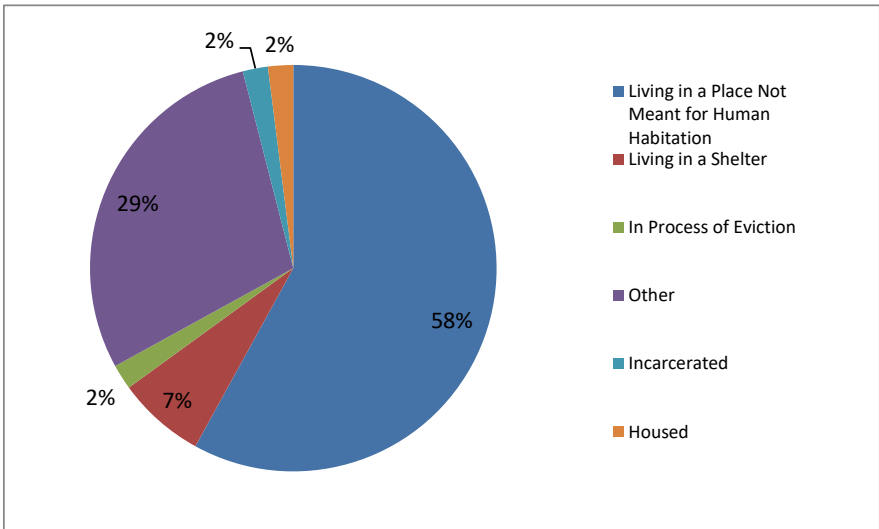

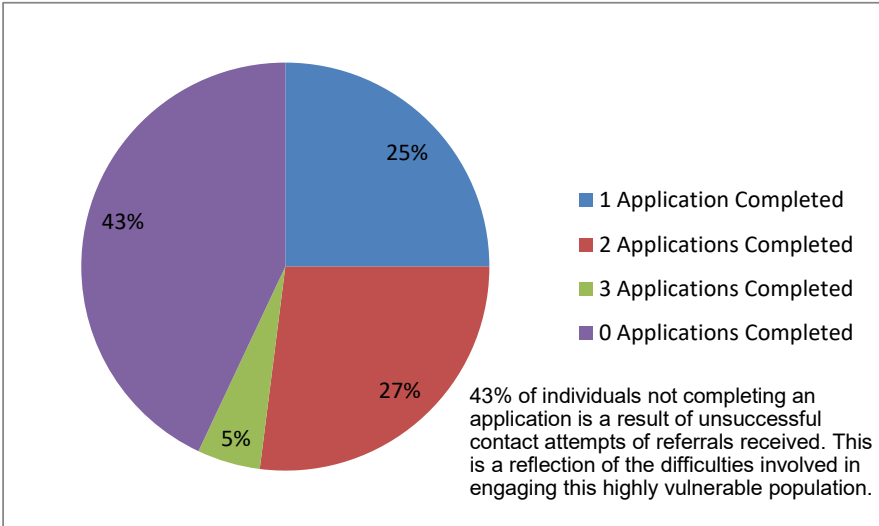


60 Individuals Served in 2016
