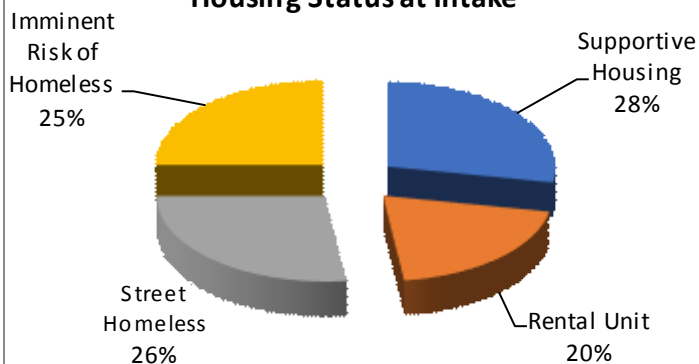

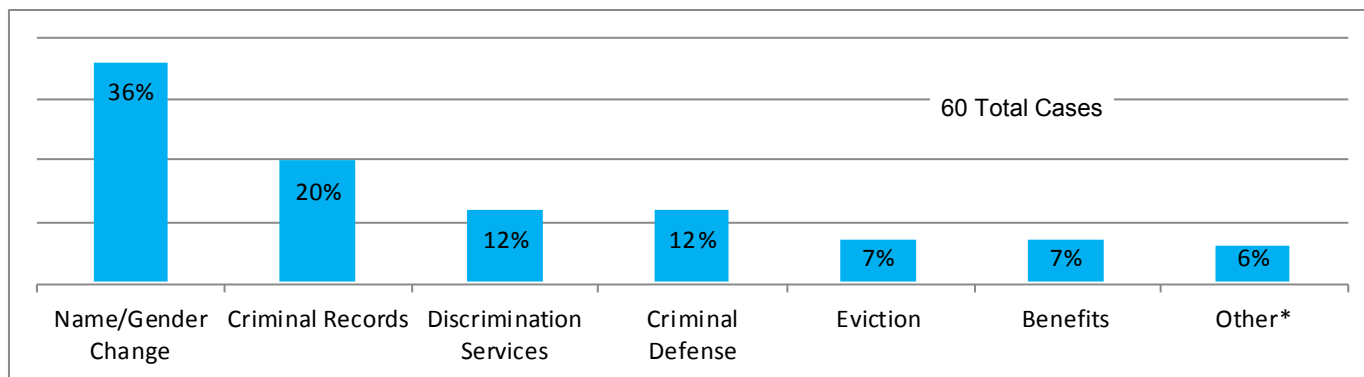
Other Legal Accomplishments

- **Legislative Challenge** to Illinois Vital Records Act to remove surgery specific requirements to change gender on birth certificate in Illinois, resulted in modernizing the Illinois Vital Records Act and allowing transgender and intersex individuals to change the gender marker on their birth certificates without undergoing gender re-assignment surgery.
- **Constitutional Challenge** to Felony Restriction in Name Changes in Illinois,
- **Training of Major Law Firms** in conducting Name Changes for transgender individuals in Illinois
